

FileMaker Training Course

Participants

This class is aimed at participants who are already familiar with data entry and find requests within FileMaker, but who have not yet explore the platform's programming tools.

Description

With our FileMaker training course for new developers, participants will learn what they need to build their first custom mobile iOS solution. They will learn how to convert Excel spreadsheets into a FileMaker Custom App and share them with their mobile devices. They will learn how to create relationships to keep their database lean, improve reporting, and how to design modern layouts that enhance the user experience.

Objectives

- 1. Create a FileMaker solution from an Excel spreadsheet
- 2. Share a FileMaker solution over a network
- 3. Establish a relationship between two tables
- 4. Build a basic interface for mobile devices

Prerequisites

Participants who attend this class must know how to:

- Create, delete and modify tables and records
- Create, delete and modify find requests
- Create, delete and modify layouts
